

HPV Causing Diseases



HPV Infection is Estimated to Cause up to 4.5% of all new Cancer Woldwide

HPV is the cause of 5% of all cancers worldwide.

It can enter your body through a simple, cut, scrape or tear in skin. Mostly it is transmitted by skin-to-skin contact or physical sexual activity. HPV infection can also be transmitted to baby if pregnant Woman has HPV infection.

IT'S A VERY COMMON INFECTION and has NO VISIBLE SYMPTOMS.

If one is infected with HPV, it can cause cancers of cervix, vagina, vulva in women and anal, penile, oropharyngeal cancers in men. It also causes genital warts both in male and females.

High-risk HPV type 16,18 is responsible for cervical cancer.

Low-risk HPV type 6,11 is responsible for genital warts.

(Caused by HPV)




Cervical cancer is cause by HIGH-RISK HPV infection.

Cervical Cancer remains the second most common cancer in Woman. It affects **5,30,000 WOMEN WORLDWIDE** and causing nearly **2,70,000 deaths annually** because of lack of awareness and screening.

In India, it is estimated that 1,25,000 new cases are detected each year and nearly 70,000 die due to undiagnosed and untreated cervical cancer. It is the common cause of EARLY DEATH among WOMEN in their reproductive years leading to devastating effect on their families and increase in social inequalities.

In India -A Woman Dies Every 9 Minutes due to Cervical Cancer

2nd leading cause of death in women between the age group of 30 - 45 years



Cervical Cancer in Women "IS PREVENTABLE" if Detected Timely and Treated

- → It can be prevented by doing test like pap smear and HPV test.
- → HPV Test is more Sensitive, Specific and Accurate.
- It can also be prevented by HPV Vaccination.
- Timely detection leads to cure.

HPV Testing-New Horizon

Ideal Method of Detection of HPV infection is by doing HPV TESTING. If your test is negative, it clearly indicates that chances of getting CERVICAL Cancer is almost ZERO for at least next 3-5 years.



Swab technique of HPV Testing

- It is easy.
- Does not require speculum/instrumentation for test.
- · Women can do it herself. It is a HPV Self-test.

Who Needs HPV Testing

All women between the age of 25-65 years.

HPV test to be done every five yearly

Test cannot be done

- 1. During Menstruation
- 2. During Pregnancy but can be done 3 months after delivery
- 3. During Vaginal infection

Caution: Do not use Vaginal creams / pessaries 48 hours before test

What if you are HPV Positive? Does it mean you Have Cancer?

NO NO NO

- HPV positive does NOT mean YOU have cancer
- 80% of HPV infection get CLEARED by YOUR IMMUNITY
- Only 20% will develop cancer in next 10 years
- So, you have 10 years of your life detect the HPV infection and to treat yourself

HPV VACCINE

Protect from HPV infection

- Helps to reduce HPV infection.
- Eliminates HPV related genital diseases and warts both in men and women.
- It prevents cervical, vaginal, vulvar cancer in Females.
- It prevents anal, penile, oral cancers in Males.
- It helps to prevent laryngeal papillomatosis in BABIES born to MOTHER who have taken HPV vaccine.



WHO CAN TAKE HPV VACCINE?

- It is Recommended in both Girls & Boys.
- Ideal age is 9 to 26 years.


